Can we ask that the children come to school with some foundation on in preparation for the performances. If you do not want your child to have any face paint, can you please inform your child's teacher.

If it is possible we encourage you to attend one of the day performances as the evening performance can be extremely busy.

As the children are performing twice on Wednesday 11th December, children will go home either after the morning performance (approx. 12 noon) or after dinner (1.10pm). Children must return to school at 6.15 pm to take part in the evening show. Children may stay in school on Wednesday 11th to have their dinner if they wish before going home. Please ensure if your child is staying for dinner that they are aware of this. We ask that all children are collected by 1.10pm.

The dinner menu will change on the two days of the play. Dinner on Tuesday 10th will be sausage, chips and a biscuit and dinner on Wednesday 11th will be chicken nuggets, chips and a biscuit.
