A Happy New Year to you all. Just a few points as we get under way again.

- 1. DVDs of the Christmas Show are available at a cost of £10. If you would like a copy please send money into school in an envelope labelled 'Mrs Goan, DVD'.
- 2. A reminder that pupils **should not** be dropped off at school before 8.45am.
- 3. Swimming at Riversdale Leisure Centre, Strabane will begin for Years 6 & 7 on Monday 3rd February. The bus will leave at approximately 10.15am and the children will be back before lunch. There will be a cost of £25 per child attending the lessons, there will be 10 weeks of swimming sessions. The remainder of the cost will be covered by school. A permission slip has also been sent home with your child today that needs to be returned to school no later than Friday 10th January confirming whether your child will be participating in the swimming programme, as due to our numbers we may need to employ an additional life guard. We ask that the £25 is sent into school by Monday 20th January.

- 7. Can I take this opportunity to remind you of the importance of school attendance. We have a dedicated Education Welfare Officer, Declan McGillian, who works with our school to discuss attendance matters. Regular school attendance is crucial in raising standards in education and ensuring that every child can have full access to the school curriculum and reach their potential. Poor overall attendance will result in communication from Mrs Goan. If the attendance rate falls below 85% and Mrs Goan does not see it improve immediately, a referral will be made to the Educational Welfare Officer (EWO). The EA, through the Education Welfare Service, have a legal duty to make sure that parents meet their responsibility towards their children's education. Please note that if your child is off school parents must send in a written note explaining why their child was absent, to ensure that it is coded correctly on the attendance register. Holidays should be taken during periods of school closure.
