6. Taking the Next Step Programme

Year 7 pupils will be participating in a new Y7 Transition Programme 'Taking the next Step'. This fully funded programme has been designed to support rural young people as they transition to secondary education, equipping them with essential life skills. The workshops cover a wide range of important topics, including risk-taking behaviours, emotional intelligence, resilience, effective communication, self regulation, health management, identity formation and principles of peace and reconciliation. We will be working with St. Caireall's in this project.

The children in Y7 will participate in workshops in Castlederg Leisure Centre on 6/3/25 and 12/3/25 as well as completing workshops in school. There is a proposed trip to Londonderry on Wednesday 2nd April to the Verbal Arts and New Gate.

7. Shared Education

Year 7 children will participate in Shared Education focusing on IZAK 9 cubes and problem solving in Castlederg High School on Tuesday 4th March and Tuesday 25th March.

8. Big Walk and Wheel

We will be carrying out our Big Walk and Wheel week from 31/3/25 to 4/4/25. This encourages children to walk, wheel, scoot or cycle to school helping to improve air quality and benefit their community. We hope the weather will be kind.
